Take a taxi to Taylors. It's the civilized way to get there. Step through the gates of this property to find immaculate gardens, a stunning terrace with wonderful views across the river to Porto and enjoy the splendid ambiance projected by the staff.

Taylor's is in my opinion among the very best of vintage ports and so it is no surprise to me that the visitor "experience" excudes that quality for which they are renowned.

You'll not be hassled to buy but frankly because you will pay more elsewhere in town for some of their wines I recommend that you take the plunge. The "chip dry" white is a bargain by my recollection. Don't make the mistake of believing that the so called duty free at the airport will be better-you'll be disappointed!

The tour is worthwhile but above all I urge you to take lunch in the terrace restaurant. Make it your main meal of the day.

The food is excellent and reasonably priced as are the wines. The service is attentive and the restaurant and its tables are presented attractively.

The moment you arrive ensure that you book your table, then take the tour and finally finish with a nice meal and a glass or two!
